Next Al introduced Austin Boyd, CEO of Inergi, Inc. and Director of Choose Life of North Alabama. Austin is

retired from the U.S. Navy, and has authored several spacerelated technical papers, as well as, a number of novels. He spoke today on the "Huntsville Crisis Pregnancy Center: Choose Life." The center is located on Rands Avenue, just behind Huntsville Hospital's Women and Children facility.

His talk was especially meaningful to me as I observe my 16year-old granddaughter, a junior at Huntsville High, being socially tempted, and to my way of thinking not always making right choices.

Patti Walker 256-829-1312 patti.walker@bxs.com Some of the statistics Mr. Boyd brought out were indeed alarming, e.g., 43% of all American women will terminate at least one pregnancy, and Huntsville has had mothers as young as 11 years old. Of the 1322 such Crisis Pregnancy Centers across our nation, Huntsville is the 2nd most active. He was quick to add, however, that activity can be credited to a loving and caring city.

More than 50 churches support the Center. More than 100 qualified volunteer counselors regularly make themselves available. Volunteer OB/GYN physicians and nurses conduct more than 120 ultrasounds per month. The current center has a patient level of about 5,000 per year, and could accommodate up to 7,000.

Ultrasound images have led to 96% of clients choosing Life, and the Christian guidance has resulted in over 250 professions of faith per year. Many of Austin's stories were highly emotional as they guide young girls through difficult times and choices and adjustments to events following any crisis pregnancy. He emphasized that all services are free. I think we're all grateful for the work of this Center.
