There being no guests, program chairman Jim Pepper introduced our speaker, Connie Carnes, CEO of HEALS Clinic. Connie explained that HEALS is to those up to 18 years of age what the Community Free Clinic is to those older and living below the poverty level. Via our

community service program we traditionally support both. Under HEALS there are currently four medical clinics and one dental clinic in operation. Connie thanked us for being a major sponsor of one of the medical clinics where Dr. Cartwright, a pediatrician, makes weekly visits. A nurse practitioner and a social worker are both there regularly each day. HEALS is ever on the look out to identify children in atrisk situations. They have found asthma and diabetes to be two of the more likely ailments. Over 1100 children were treated for these and various other sicknesses during the past year. Their income is from Medicaid, grants, and fund-raising efforts. Without HEALS it's hard to imagine how those in poverty survive. There is a definite need for more clinics.

Alberto reminded members of the September 24<sup>th</sup> pancake breakfast, and he passed around a sign-up sheet for workers. He mentioned again that Fabiani will be talking to Middle School Principals at a November meeting. Also, at next week's business meeting he's hoping the club will authorize the usual purchases connected with new JOOI Clubs (banners etc.).
