Secretary – Treasurer Al Renz gave his report. The club is doing well with a bank balance of 12,589.16.

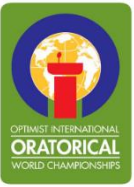
Committee Reports



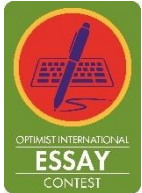

The Lincoln academy JOI Club is on hold until the next school year.

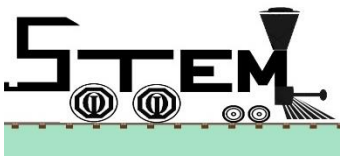
Alberto mentioned five JOI clubs are up and running. Randolph would like to provide boxes for the military. Still in the process of collecting more information.
