After our meal, 1st Vice President Demetria Braudaway introduced our speaker, Dorothy Havens, Workforce Development Director for Ktech, a workforce initiative of the Kids to Love Foundation.

Dorothy has more than 35 years of progressive experience in sales, company management, advertising, marketing, event planning, human resources, operations and financial management. In 2015 she joined Lee Marshall and the Kids to Love Foundation as the Director of Workforce Development for KTECH.

KTECH is a workforce training initiative of the Kids to Love Foundation. The training provided by KTECH helps the underserved population attain the necessary skills in Mechatronics. These skills are used in the advanced manufacturing industry.

The students complete four levels of studies in the Mechatronics Lab covering Electrical Components, Mechanical Components and Electrical Drives, Electro Pneumatic and Hydraulic Control Circuits, and Digital Fundamentals and Programmable Logic Controllers.

They also attend classes in the Life Lab where they study character, wisdom, knowledge and influence.

In addition to the Mechatronics Diploma track students may obtain certification in soldering, earning the Credential: IPC-J-STD-001 Certified IPC Application Specialist or in robotics, earning the Credential: Yaskawa Industrial Robotic Certification in FS100 Basic.

After her talk President Lee gave Dorothy an Optimist Creed Coaster as a token of our appreciation for speaking to us.
