been serving children and their families since 1969. Leah did a slide presentation that covered the services offered in the areas of Adoption, Domestic & International Home Study Services, Birth Parent Counseling and Foster Care.

She pointed out that in the United States, there are over 500,000 children in foster care, but in addition, thousands more are removed each year from their homes because of abuse and neglect by their families. Foster homes are needed for these children and Agape is one of the providers our state turns to in order to find temporary (and sometimes permanent) homes for these precious souls. Leah passed out 4 brochures that detail the material she covered.


