

#### Finances

President Alfred then called on me to give my monthly financial report. I reported that for the 7 months, October thru April, we had revenues of \$ 11,054.20 and expenses of \$ 7,773.18 for a net of \$ 3,281.02. I also pointed out that since most of our dues are paid during the first month of the quarter, we could expect a loss during the May-June period, but that we should finish the 9 months ending June with net income well in excess of \$ 2,000. Our youth activities expenditures for the 7 months were \$ 11,639.12 and we had been reimbursed by the Foundation for all but \$ 3,209.74 and that amount had been submitted for reimbursement.

### **Committee Reports**

I reported that our Community Service Grant program is in its final stage. All committee members have voted and I have compiled a proposed grant distribution based on the input I received. If there is any major disagreement we will get together and come to a unanimous decision. That will then be presented to the club and if approved it will be presented to the Foundation.

President Alfred talked about the Youth Appreciation Banquet and that in his opinion it was a huge success. He complimented Gay on an outstanding job, and for the work that Tom and others did to make it a success.



Tom Casteel reported that the Band Committee members are actively picking up band instruments from the schools and attending concerts.



Blue Plate Gay reported that she had talked to Blue Plate restaurant and they expect to be in business in about 30 days. Until we can

try them out, we will continue to meet at Optimist Park.

Tom brought up our annual summer picnic, stating that it had been held at Ford's Chapel pavilion the past year and that it had worked out well there. After some discussion, it was decided to bring it up at the next board meeting.

President Alfred reported that the board had decided to have another pecan sale fund raiser and details would be forthcoming.

## Closing

There being no new business, President Alfred asked Dr. Carl Winkler to lead us in the reciting or our Creed, which he did in normal exuberant way. I love the way you do it Carl.
